Brian Lloyd named PUC Executive Director **Former PUC staffer begins Dec. 1**

The Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUC) announced on Wednesday that Brian Lloyd will become Executive Director of the agency effective Dec. 1.

With extensive experience in both the electric and energy industries, Mr. Lloyd worked at the PUC for more than 10 years, spearheading several agency projects and working as a Director of oversight of the retail electric industry. He was the primary author of several agency reports to the Texas Legislature and testified before legislative committees, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) and the PUC.

He currently serves as Deputy Director of Budget, Planning and Policy for Gov. Rick Perry and was a key contributor to the Texas State Energy Plan. Lloyd began work at the Governor's office in 2008 as an advisor on energy and utilities policy.

Mr. Lloyd earned a bachelor's degree in economics at Louisiana State University and graduated from the University of Texas at Austin with a master's degree in economics.

The Executive Director of the PUC is an administrative position separate from the three voting Commissioners who are appointed by the Governor.

The PUC currently has 183 employees. The previous Executive Director, Lane Lanford, resigned in August after accepting the position of Director of Compliance for the Texas Reliability Entity.
