Public Utility Commission of Texas Chairman Peter Lake and Electric Reliability Council of Texas CEO Brad Jones will hold a press conference to discuss the readiness of the Texas power grid for the 2022 summer season. Chairman Lake and Jones will highlight the ongoing impacts of landmark grid reliability and electricity market reforms passed by the Texas Legislature, signed by Gov. Greg Abbott, and implemented by the PUC and ERCOT in the past year.

They will also provide an overview of ERCOT's Seasonal Assessment of Resource Adequacy (SARA) and Capacity, Demand and Reserves (CDR) reports. Those reports can be found here:
