**ORDER NO. 2  
GRANTING GOOD CAUSE EXCEPTION  
TO 2001 REP FILING REQUIREMENT**

This Order grants a good cause exception to the 2001 annual filing requirement of P.U.C. SUBST. R. 25.107(i)(4) that directs REPs to file reports providing updated contact information, identification of service territory, and description of other business requirements.

P.U.C. SUBST. R. 25.107(i)(4) requires Retail Electric Providers (REP) to file by June 1 each calendar year a report that contains certain information for the preceding calendar year. A REP's first annual report is due in the year following the calendar year in which it is awarded a certificate. Because only four REPs received certification in calendar year 2000, and those certifications were granted in late November and December, the Commission finds that updated information is not necessary at this time. Therefore, the Commission grants a good cause exception to the filing requirement of P.U.C. SUBST. R. 25.107(i)(4) for 2001.
