**ORDER ADMINISTRATIVELY ESTABLISHING ACCESS LINE RATES  
FOR THE VILLAGE OF WEBBERVILLE**

This Order administratively establishes the fee per access line rates for the Village of Webberville, Texas (Village). This Order is necessary because the Village did not initially participate in the process of establishing fee per access line rates under TEX. LOC. GOV'T. CODE Chapter 283, but now elects to set such rates. On June 20, 2005, the Commission delegated authority to the Docket Management Division to administratively approve CPI adjusted fees per access line rates for newly participating or newly incorporated cities using statewide average rates where such statewide average rates have been adjusted to reflect the Commission approved CPI adjustment made in accordance with P.U.C. SUBST. R. 26.467(j) and TEX. LOC. GOV'T. CODE § 283.055(g).<sup>1</sup> This Order is issued under that authority.

Staff calculated maximum fee per access line rates for the Village using statewide average rates for the dominant carrier, which is SBC Texas. The Village has elected to adopt its maximum rates as its city-preferred rates. Accordingly, the maximum fee per access line rates for the Village is shown in the table below. These rates shall be applied prospectively from the date of this Order and shall be implemented no later than December 1, 2005.
