Work Sessions

General Information

Commission work sessions are informal meetings of agency leadership where potential rules, policy topics, and other issues of interest to the commission are discussed. Work sessions may be used by the commissioners for information gathering or to provide guidance to staff about policy direction and priorities. Aside from the commissioners, typical work session participants include the executive director, the deputy executive director, agency staff, and invited subject matter experts. Because work sessions will be attended by at least two commissioners, they are therefore subject to the Texas Open Meetings Act.



Most work sessions are held in the Commissioners' Hearing Room on the 7th floor of the William B. Travis Building at 1700 North Congress Avenue in Austin. They are live-streamed for your convenience on our [Broadcasts page](#). The live meeting video is archived and accessible online.

Work session agendas must receive approval at least eight calendar days prior to the work session. Once the commissioners have approved an agenda, it is published on the Secretary of State's Open Meetings page and the PUC's [Open Meetings and Agendas](#) page.
