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PUC to Webcast training session this week for public filings via Internet

New and improved method lets customers file documents online

The Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUC) has scheduled Feb. 1 as the launch of the Internet-based “PUC Filer,” which will allow the public filing of documents directly to the agency’s central records.

A training session will be held Friday, Jan. 27 at 10 a.m. at PUC headquarters located on the seventh floor of the Travis Building, 1701 N. Congress Ave., Austin, TX 78701. The session will be Webcast live at <http://www.texasadmin.com/tx/puct/> A replay will be available at this Website shortly after the session ends.
