**RULEMAKING TO MONITOR THE § PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION  
ESTABLISHMENT AND ALLOCATION §  
OF CERTAIN 9-1-1 FEES § OF TEXAS**

**ORDER GRANTING SOUTHWESTERN BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY'S MOTION  
FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE ALTERNATIVE TARIFFS**

On July 7, 2000, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) filed a Motion for Extension of Time to file alternative tariffs which provide 9-1-1 administrative entities the option to purchase any separately offered and priced 9-1-1 service. SWBT requested an extension of time until August 24, 2000, in order to give all interested parties time to review draft tariffs before they are filed for approval with the Commission.

On July 13, 2000, SCC Communications Corporation (SCC) filed its response to SWBT's motion. On July 14, 2000, the 9-1-1 administrative agencies also filed a response. Neither party opposed the extension of time based on the fact that SWBT committed to providing draft tariffs by July 25, 2000. The Commission believes that this extension will allow the parties an opportunity to resolve issues informally and possibly expedite resolution of 9-1-1 unbundling issues. Therefore, the Commission orders that SWBT's Motion for Extension of Time to File Alternate Tariffs be granted.
